About the organisation of the study process In the academic year 2021/2022 in LLU

Based on the requirements set in Cabinet of Ministers Regulation of 28 September 2021, No. 662 "Epidemiological safety measures to limit the spread of Covid-19 infection" and Cabinet of Ministers Order of 9 October 2021, No. 720 "Regarding Declaration of the Emergency Situation" to ensure epidemiological safety at Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies (LLU), **I determine:**

- 1. The study process of LLU from **15 November 2021 will continue** according to the schedule of **on-site** classes for all types of levels of studies.
- 2. On-site classes are organised in an epidemiologically safe environment and are attended by students, faculty, and staff involved in the study process with an interoperable vaccination or Covid-19 recovery certificate.
- 3. Students, teaching staff, and staff involved in the study process, who have a decision from the Council of Riga Eastern Clinical University to postpone vaccination for a certain period of time, shall participate in the study process remotely until the completion of a full vaccination course.
- 4. Every day of the study process, upon arrival at the premises of the Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies, students, teaching staff and staff involved in the study process sign a health certification, which is created in the form of a joint list (attached).
- 5. The certifications shall be submitted to the Dean's offices of the faculties by the responsible person appointed by the dean of the faculty no later than on the next working day, and they shall be kept for at least one calendar month.
- 6. The students, teaching staff and the staff involved in the study process of the faculties (Faculty of Agriculture and Faculty of Information Technology) located in Jelgava, Lielā iela 2 (Jelgava Castle) sign the certifications in the form of a joint list with all the employees (staff) of Jelgava Castle; they are kept by the manager of the study building of Jelgava Castle for at least one calendar month.
- 7. The procedure for verifying an interoperable vaccination certificate or certificate confirming recovery from Covid-19 is determined by a separate order of the Rector of LLU.
- 8. Persons who provide false information about the interoperable vaccination certificate or certificate confirming recovery from Covid-19, or present falsified documents, will be held liable in accordance with the regulatory enactments.
- 9. The director of the study programme, in coordination with the dean of the faculty and the Study Centre, has accepted a reasoned decision to carry out the study programme course or module remotely, in full or partially, ensuring that the level of study quality does not decrease. The director of the study programme informs the students about making such a

- decision. In the distance learning process, students and lecturers use the LLU e-learning system.
- 10. The Vice-Rector for Studies is responsible for ensuring epidemiological safety measures in the organisation of the study process.
- 11. To declare invalid Rector's Order No. 4.3-13/67 of 11 October 2021 "On the organisation of the study process at LLU 2021/2022".
