We recommend if you do not want to take Taxi then the best plan would be Arrive at airport:

- 1. "Purchase an e-ticket at the Narvesen kiosk or buy it online at: https://www.rigassatiksme.lv/en/tickets-and-e-ticket/code-tickets/
- 2. Board bus No. 22 at the designated bus stop.
- 3. Head towards the city center. If you're taking the bus to Jelgava, alight at the '13.janvāra iela/Autoosta' stop.
 - o If you're taking the train, disembark from the bus at the 'Gogola iela/Centrāltirgus' stop.

Additionally, for travel from Riga to Jelgava, minibuses are more frequent (with limited capacity). opt for the train if you're carrying a lot of baggage."

From Riga to Jelgava, there are three options:

Buses (Riga SAO- Jelgava AO)

Intercity/International Buses from Rīga to Jelgavas AO - 1188 transport

You can buy tickets at the ticket desk which is inside the station or from the driver.

It will take you 55 min for 2,40 EUR to reach Jelgava.

From Riga Central Train Station

For <u>aprox</u>. 60 Euro in up to 60 min you can reach Jelgava from all major traffic points of Riga.
